

Quality goals for 2025

1. Ensuring a high level of flight safety by complying with the standards required by the aviation authorities (State Aviation Administration of Ukraine), Aviation Rules of Ukraine approved by order No. 682, Part-M/Subpart G, Part-145, Part-21, Part-147 requirements and own requirements for the implementation of commercial, operational and production activities.
2. Expanding the Aviation Company's helicopter fleet to 24 helicopters.
3. Approval of new supporting office for continuing airworthiness management.
4. Approval of new maintenance bases.
5. Approval of the PJSC AC Ukrainian helicopters branch in the Republic of Kenya for:
 - maintenance;
 - theoretical and practical training of maintenance personnel;
 - flight crew training (training flights).
6. Transition to new maintenance scheduled pursuant for Mil-8MTV-1 helicopters.
7. Personnel training for independent airworthiness review of helicopters of Mil-8MTV and Mil-172 types.
8. Expanding import substitution of helicopter's components.
9. Contracting 20 helicopters for various contractors.
10. Modernization of helicopters in according to the documentation of the Design Approval Organization PJSC AC Ukrainian helicopters, Approval Certificate UA.21J.0041: installation of additional equipment for night aerial firefighting on 3 helicopters, replacement of flight instruments on 3 helicopters, replacement of avionics on 4 helicopters.
11. Achieving a mean time between failures of at least 40 hours.
12. Consistent improvement of the professional level of crew members and specialists who ensure the production activity of PJSC AC Ukrainian helicopters.
13. Certification of PJSC AC Ukrainian helicopters for compliance with the international standard ISO 14001: 2015 Environmental management systems.
